....e.g. job seeking:

Soft skills of the job applicant can help the recruiters to...

...to choose between qualified candidates who meet the typical requirements for the job.

<u>Example</u>: When two candidates have a similar academic and professional background, you're more likely to hire the one who's more collaborative and flexible.

... hire for potential; not just knowledge.

<u>Example:</u> For a junior position, it makes sense to look for candidates with a "willingness to learn" and an "adaptive personality", as opposed to hiring an expert.
